Did you know?

- **::** Champaign was included in Livability's Top 25 Places to Live in the Midwest, citing amenities such as accessible parks, short commute, affordability, diverse cultures, and a spirit of innovation.
- The University of Illinois Urbana-Champaign moved back into the top 10 of PitchBook's Top Ten for Startup Founders. This annual ranking of universities is based on the number of venture capital-backed companies started by alumni.
- **::** The companion animal nutrition program at Illinois is one of the oldest in the nation. Our researchers contributed to some of the first commercial puppy food formulations, and today they're studying everything from weight loss diets to alternative fibers supporting pet microbiomes.
- **::** The University of Illinois Rare Book & Manuscript Library (RBML) contains the largest public university collection of rare books and manuscripts in the United States as part of the public trust. The collections—nearly 500,000 volumes and just over two linear miles of manuscript material encompass the broad areas of literature, history, art, theology, philosophy, technology, and the natural sciences.
- : Each year, nearly 12 million rides are handled by the Champaign-Urbana Mass Transit District (MTD). To put this in perspective, fellow Midwest cities Nashville and Indianapolis (both substantially bigger) provide approximately 10 million rides each year.
