Using governmental data, CoworkingCafe's annual Women in Tech series ranks metro areas by the share of female tech workers, their earnings, unemployment and health insurance rates, along with broader professional metrics. CU also boasts increased growth in female tech workers, with women making up 28% of the region's workforce following a significant 113% increase between 2019 and 2023.
